Built on an impressively large and thoughtfully secure campus, MDA houses Israel's life-saving blood bank as well as provides emergency support services all over the country. On a daily basis, MDA processes 1200 blood donations and has the capacity to process four times that amount during times of need. Constantly innovating, MDA also outfits its emergency care vehicles to provide life-saving care such as all terrain wheels that can climb over uneven surfaces and a 7-room ICU bus. MDA also houses a mothers' milk bank.
