ARMY RANGER BEANIE



Materials:

Needles:

Size 16" (#8) circular needles Size 8 double point needles

Yarn: 200-225 yards of any yarn from the Knots of Love's approved hat of yarns.

Tapestry needle 11 Stitch markers





Instructions:

Using 16" (#8) circular needles

Cast on 80 sts.

Place a stitch marker at the beginning of your round being careful not to twist the stitches.

Brim: K1, P1 for 3 inches

Body:

Rnds 1-2: K1, P1. Repeat around.

Rnds 3-4: P1, K1. Repeat around.

Continue working rounds 1-4 until your work measures 9" from cast on edge.

Crown: Change to double point needles or two circular needles when needed.

Rnd 1: "K1, P1, K1, P1, K1, P1, P2tog. Repeat from " to end of round. (Place a stitch marker after each section.)

Rnd 2: "K1, P1, K1, P1, K1, P1, P1. Repeat from " to end of round.

Rnd 3: "P1, K1, P1, K1, P1, P2tog. Repeat from " to end of round.

Rnd 4: 'P1, K1, P1, K1, P1, P1. Repeat from 'to end of round.

Rnd 5: *K1, P1, K1, P1, P2tog. Repeat from * to end of round.

Rnd 6: "K1, P1, K1, P1, P1. Repeat from " to end of round.

Rnd 7: "P1, K1, P1, P2tog. Repeat from ' to end of round.

Rnd 8: "P1, K1, P1, P1. Repeat from " to end of round.

Rnd 9: "K1, P1, P2tog. Repeat from " to end of round.

Rnd 10: "K1, P2tog

Finishing: Only 2 stitches remain in each section. Cut yarn, leaving a long tail. Thread tail through remaining stitches and remove stitches from the needles. Pull to gather and close the top opening. Weave in the remaining tail.

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OCCASIONAL PURL PATTERN



Materials:

Needles: Size 8 (16" inch) Circular Needles, double point needles

Yarn: 200-225 yards of any yarn from the Knots of Love's

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Instructions:

Cast on 72 or 80 stitches

BRIM:

Variation 1: (Preferred): K around fro 10 rounds.

Variation 2:

Row 1: "K1, p1; rep from " to end of row. Row 2: "P1, k1; rep from " to end of row. Rep Rows 1 and 2 for pattern for 1 to 1.5"

Variation 3: Pictured: Knit 1 row, Purl 1 row to the desired width.


Rnd 1: Knit around

Rnd 2: Knit around Rnd 7: Knit around

Rnd 3: Knit around Rnd 8: K2, P1, *(K3, P1), Repeat from * around, K remaining stitch.

Rnd 4: P1, K3 around Rnd 9: Knit around Rnd 5: Knit around Rnd 10: Knit around Rnd 11: Knit around

Repeat rounds 4 -11 until cap reaches 6.5 inches from brim



When circular needles become too long for the decreasing amount of stitches, begin knitting off onto double point needles, 2 sections per needle. Or, if you know how to work in the round with 2 circulars, divide the knitting in half while knitting around.

Rnd 1: Knit 6, knit 2 together. Repeat around.

Rnd 2: And each even number round knit plain around

Rnd 3: Knit 5, knit 2 together.

Rnd 5: Knit 4, knit 2 together.

Rnd 7: Knit 3, knit 2 together.

Rnd 9: Knit 2, knit 2 together.

Rnd 11: Knit 1, K2 together.

Rnd 13: K2 together

Finishing:

Only 2 stitches remain in each section. Break yarn, leaving 12". Thread onto a tapestry needle and loosely thread through the remaining stitches. Thread through a 2nd time and pull tightly to close the remaining hole. Thread to inside and stitch in place to secure. Weave in and out of a few stitches, clip remaining yarn.

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
